

Tell me more about the Guided Busway ...

What's in it for me?

The County Council is holding an exhibition about the Cambridgeshire Guided Busway and staff will be available to answer any questions you may have.



The Guided Busway will provide high quality, reliable and frequent bus services on a dedicated and segregated route from St Ives to Cambridge.

Buses using the guideway will stop at St Ives, Swavesey, Longstanton, Oakington, Histon & Impington, Arbury Park, Cambridge Regional College, the Science Park, Cambridge city centre, Cambridge railway station, Addenbrooke's hospital, Trumpington and Trumpington Park & Ride. There will also be a request stop at the Fen Drayton nature reserve.



Other buses serving surrounding villages will also be able to join the guideway to make the final part of their journey into Cambridge.

As part of the busway project two brand new Park & Ride sites will also be built in St Ives and Longstanton.
